The Year 10 Taster Program allows eligible high school students to try out an industry area without needing to commit to a full qualification or apprenticeship. Students get to see if an industry area is the right option for them, or test out a potential career path that they're considering following in the future. Students will complete individual competencies from various programs but will not complete a full certificate or obtain any QCE credits.
